NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the West Side Health Care District (“District” or “Owner”) invites and will receive sealed bids for the furnishing of certain clinical and non-clinical equipment (collectively, the “Equipment”) for the WSFHC Dental Clinic Project.

Sealed bids must be delivered to the District no later than 10:00 a.m. (Pacific Daylight Savings Time) on May 20, 2026, at the District’s Administrative Office located at 115 Adkisson Way, Taft, CA 93268, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud.

A non-mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held on May 12, 2026 at 1:00 p.m. via Zoom. The Zoom meeting link and access information will be made available on the District’s website at wshcd.org or by request by contacting the District office at rshultz@wshcd.org.

Invitations for Bids and Bidding Documents, including a list of the Equipment sought for the Project (the “Equipment List”), may be obtained beginning April 29, 2026, at 2:00 p.m. (P.D.S.T.) by email request rshultz@wshcd.org, hard copy (for a nonrefundable fee of \$25.00 per set) from West Side Health Care District 115 Adkisson Way, Taft, CA 93268, or on the District’s website wshcd.org.

The District seeks the Equipment for a dental office consisting of five (5) dental exam rooms, a lab and sterile room, dental x-ray, as well as necessary mechanical, water, suction and air equipment systems. The Equipment List specifies the manufacturer, model and quantity of the desired Equipment. Final detailed specifications of the Stericenter included on the Equipment List will be subject to approval by the District. Each bidder is to include any necessary fabrication, setup, storage and white glove installation costs in its submitted bid for the Equipment. As part of its bid, each bidder shall include the cost of all necessary and customary warranties, software, software upgrades and in-office trainings as required for the Equipment. All installation shall be coordinated with the Owner.

This project is a public works project subject to the provisions of California Labor Code Section 1770 et seq., including compliance with prevailing wage requirements. Pursuant to Labor Code Section 1773, the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) has determined the general prevailing wage rates in Kern County. Copies of the prevailing wage rates are on file with the District and may also be obtained from the DIR website.

This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the DIR under Labor Code Section 1771.4. No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal or awarded a contract unless registered with the DIR pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5.

The District reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any irregularity, and to take all bids under advisement for a period not to exceed 60 calendar days.

GENERAL PROJECT REQUIREMENTS

PROJECT SITE

The project site is located at 100 E. North Street, Taft, CA 93268. A general depiction of the geographical location of the project site is attached hereto.

SCOPE OF WORK

The District seeks certain clinical and non-clinical equipment (collectively, the “Equipment”) for the WSFHC Dental Clinic Project (the “Project”). The Project includes a dental office consisting of five (5) dental exam rooms, a lab and sterile room, dental x-ray, as well as necessary mechanical, water, suction and air equipment systems. The District is making available to prospective bidders a list of the Equipment sought, which specifies the manufacturer, model and quantity of the desired equipment (the “Equipment List”). Final detailed specifications and measurements of the Stericenter included on the Equipment List (“Custom Stericenter”) will be subject to field measurements and approval by the District. Each bidder is to include any necessary fabrication, setup, storage and white glove installation costs in its submitted bid for the Equipment (together with sale of the Equipment, referred to herein as the “Work”). As part of its bid, each bidder shall include the cost of all necessary and customary warranties, software, software upgrades and in-office trainings as required for the Equipment. All installation shall be coordinated with the Owner.

CONTRACT

Contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder submitting a responsive bid. Provided, however, West Side Health Care District reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any irregularities. If a bidder’s proposal is accepted by Owner, but the bidder fails to contract with Owner, the Owner, at its option, may determine that the bidder has abandoned the contract, and whereupon the bidder’s proposed bid and the Owner’s acceptance thereof shall be null and void.

INSPECTIONS

Bidders are required to fully inform themselves of the conditions relating to construction and labor under which the Work will be performed. Execution of a contract by and between the successful bidder (“Vendor” or “Contractor”) and Owner shall be deemed a representation by said Vendor that the Vendor has visited and carefully examined the site, become familiar with the local conditions under which the Work is to be performed, and has satisfied itself as to the conditions encountered and the requirements to complete the Work in accordance with said contract (the “Contract”).

PERMITS

Unless otherwise provided in the Contract, the Vendor shall secure and pay for all required permits, fees and licenses necessary for the proper performance and completion of the Work. The Vendor shall also give all notices and comply with all laws, ordinances, rules, regulations and orders of any public authority bearing on the performance of the Work.

TIME FOR COMPLETION

The time for completion of the Work is January 23, 2027. The installation of the Custom Stericenter located in the Lab/Sterile Room shall be completed by December 1, 2026.

GOVERNING LAW

The Contract shall be governed by the law of the State of California.

FAIR EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES

In connection with the performance of Work under the Contract, the Vendor agrees (in accordance with Government Code section 12900 et seq. and Labor Code section 1735) not to discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, religion, physical disability, mental disability, medical condition, marital status or sex.

LICENSING

No bid will be accepted from anyone who does not hold a valid business license and applicable seller's permit. No bid will be accepted by a bidder whose contractor or sub-contractor assigned to install fixed equipment who has not been licensed in accordance with provisions of Chapter 9 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. All vendors, contractors and subcontractors will be required to obtain the required business license.

INSURANCE POLICIES REQUIRED OF VENDOR

Without limiting the Owner's right to obtain indemnification from Contractor or any third parties, Contractor, at its sole expense, shall maintain in full force and effect the insurance policies (of the types and amounts) described below throughout the term of the Contract (except to the extent a longer term is specified for policies herein or in the Contract):

Commercial General Liability Insurance: Contractor shall maintain Commercial General Liability Insurance with limits of not less than two million dollars (\$2,000,000) per occurrence and an annual aggregate of three million dollars (\$3,000,000). The Owner, its officers, directors, employees, agents, including its consulting engineers, and volunteers, are to be covered as additional insureds. The coverage shall contain no special limitations on the scope of protection afforded to the additional insureds.

Automobile Liability Insurance: Contractor shall maintain Comprehensive Automobile

Liability Insurance with limits of not less than two million dollars (\$2,000,000) per accident for bodily injury and property damage. Coverage is to include owned and non-owned vehicles used in connection with the Contract and all applicable endorsements.

Worker's Compensation Insurance: Contractor shall maintain Workers' Compensation Insurance in the amounts required by law and Employer's Liability Insurance with limits of at least one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for Contractor's employees. Contractor shall also require each subcontractor to similarly maintain Worker's Compensation Insurance and Employer's Liability Insurance in accordance with applicable law for all of the subcontractor's employees.

The insurer for each such policy shall agree to waive all rights of subrogation against the Owner, its officers, directors, employees, agents, and volunteers for losses arising from work performed by the Contractor (and by each subcontractor) on the project.

Other Insurance Requirements: Contractor shall obtain the policies and coverages specified herein from an admitted insurer in good standing with and authorized to transact business in California by the Department of Insurance. Each such insurer is to have an AM Best's rating of not less than A and FAC VIII. All policies shall be endorsed to provide to Owner with not less than thirty (30) days' prior notice of cancellation (except for nonpayment, for which not less than ten (10) days' prior notice is required) or nonrenewal of coverage for each coverage required hereunder. Contractor shall provide certificates of insurance and upon request from Owner, formal endorsements of the foregoing policies, as required herein. Evidence of the insurance required hereunder must be provided to and approved by Owner prior to commencement of performance of the Work. Owner reserves the right to require complete, certified copies of all required insurance policies, at any time. In the event Contractor fails to keep in effect at all times insurance coverage as herein required, the Owner may, in addition to other remedies it may have, suspend or terminate the Contract. Contractor shall include all of its subcontractors as insured under its policies or shall furnish separate certificates and endorsements for each subcontractor. All coverages for subcontractors shall be subject to each of the requirements stated herein above for Contractor's insurance.

Owner reserves the right (at Owner's sole and absolute discretion) to agree to modifications and/or supplementation of the foregoing insurance requirements in the Contract.

SUBMISSION OF PROPOSALS

The bidder shall prepare his proposal on the blank proposal form furnished by the Owner. The bidder shall specify a lump sum price in both words and figures for each bid item, including alternates, additives and supplemental items.

All words and figures shall be in ink. In case of a discrepancy between the prices written in words and those written in figures, the written words shall govern.

Alternate or conditional bids will not be accepted unless called for in the Contract.

The bidder's proposal shall be signed in ink by an authorized representative of the bidder.

The required proposal guaranty must accompany the proposal.

Bid proposals and all other requested documents referenced in this Invitation to Bid are to be delivered to the West Side Health Care District, 115 Adkisson Way, Taft, CA 93268, and are to be identified as BID – WEST SIDE FAMILY HEALTH CARE DENTAL CLINIC - EQUIPMENT. Bids must be received by no later than until 10:00 a.m. (P.D.S.T.) on May 20, 2026.

FORM OF AGREEMENT

The Contract for the purchase of Equipment shall be in the form of the Vendor's standard and customary sales agreement, subject to such modifications and other changes as may be requested by Owner and accepted by Vendor. In no event shall the Contract contain terms that conflict with applicable provisions of the California Public Contract Code or other governing laws and regulations applicable to this Project.

Contractor shall fully perform the entire Scope of Work as described herein above for the price stated in this bid.

Commencement and Substantial Completion: Work shall commence when the Contract is executed by Vendor and Owner (“Contract Execution”). Contractor shall not incur any expense until Contract Execution. Contractor shall not make any purchases of equipment, supplies or materials, or begin any work, until receiving a Notice to Proceed from Owner following Contract Execution. If awarded the Contract, Contractor shall substantially complete the scope of work in accordance with the Contract and shall do so by January 23, 2027 and complete the installation of the Stericenter in the Lab/Sterile Room by December 1, 2026, subject only to adjustments as provided in the Contract.

Bid holding time: Contractor agrees that this bid may not be revoked or withdrawn by Contractor after the time set for the opening of bids in the Notice to Bidders, and shall remain open for potential acceptance by Owner for a period of sixty (60) days after the bid due date.

Bid amount: The total price shall be that listed below. The price must reflect the entire cost to complete the Scope of Work. Bid amount must be firm and fixed, and shall include all associated costs (including, but not limited to, all charges for labor, materials, supplies, and equipment; fees; disposal costs; costs associated with permitting, taxes, insurance, bonding, and complying with all General Conditions; and overhead and profit). In case of a discrepancy between words and figures, the words shall prevail. If this proposal is accepted by Owner and the undersigned fails to contract with the Owner within ten (10) days after the award of the contract, the Owner, at its option, may determine that the bidder has abandoned the contract, and thereupon this proposal and the acceptance thereof shall be null and void, and the forfeiture of such security accompanying this proposal shall operate and the same shall be the property of the Owner.

The undersigned, as bidder, declares that all Addenda issued with respect to this bid have been received and incorporated into this Proposal. The bidder's signature on this Proposal also constitutes acknowledgement of all Addenda.

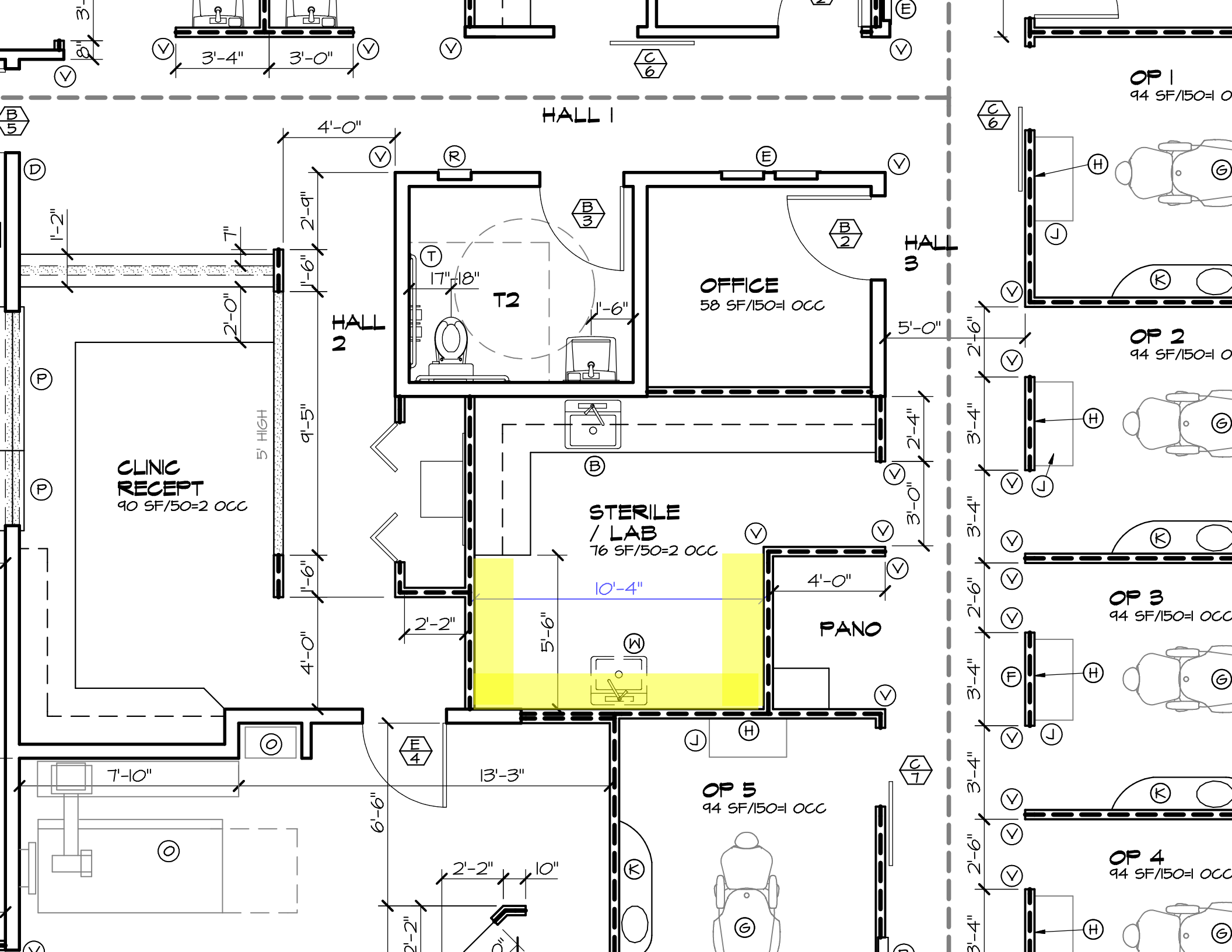

EXHIBIT B

Custom Pre-fabricated Stericenter Specifications

The Custom Stericenter shall be included in the Vendor's bid as a fixed price. The final design shall be subject to approval by the Owner. The location of the Stericenter can be found in the WSFHC Dental Clinic Construction Plans A-2.0 Floor Plan inside the room labeled as Sterile/Lab. A visual aid is provided with this exhibit identifying the install location. The custom Stericenter cabinetry shall fit an approximate space of 5'6" by 10'4" (U-Shaped). All final dimensions shall be subject to owner approval and require field measurement verification. The Vendor shall include the appropriate cabinetry to fit Equipment #23, #24, #25, #26, #27 and #38 with accommodations for both Clean and Dirty lab spaces. The Stericenter shall include hard surfaced counter tops and a 36" sink.
