NOTICE TO BIDDERS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the West Side Health Care District (“District” or “Owner”) invites and will receive sealed bids for the furnishing of certain clinical and non-clinical equipment (collectively, the “Equipment”) for the WSFHC Dental Clinic Project.

Sealed bids must be delivered to the District no later than 10:00 a.m. (Pacific Daylight Savings Time) on May 20, 2026, at the District’s Administrative Office located at 115 Adkisson Way, Taft, CA 93268, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud.

A non-mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held on May 12, 2026 at 1:00 p.m. via Zoom. The Zoom meeting link and access information will be made available on the District’s website at wshcd.org or by request by contacting the District office at rshultz@wshcd.org.

Invitations for Bids and Bidding Documents, including a list of the Equipment sought for the Project (the “Equipment List”), may be obtained beginning April 29, 2026, at 2:00 p.m. (P.D.S.T.) by email request rshultz@wshcd.org, hard copy (for a nonrefundable fee of \$25.00 per set) from West Side Health Care District 115 Adkisson Way, Taft, CA 93268, or on the District’s website wshcd.org.

The District seeks the Equipment for a dental office consisting of five (5) dental exam rooms, a lab and sterile room, dental x-ray, as well as necessary mechanical, water, suction and air equipment systems. The Equipment List specifies the manufacturer, model and quantity of the desired Equipment. Final detailed specifications of the Stericenter included on the Equipment List will be subject to approval by the District. Each bidder is to include any necessary fabrication, setup, storage and white glove installation costs in its submitted bid for the Equipment. As part of its bid, each bidder shall include the cost of all necessary and customary warranties, software, software upgrades and in-office trainings as required for the Equipment. All installation shall be coordinated with the Owner.

This project is a public works project subject to the provisions of California Labor Code Section 1770 et seq., including compliance with prevailing wage requirements. Pursuant to Labor Code Section 1773, the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) has determined the general prevailing wage rates in Kern County. Copies of the prevailing wage rates are on file with the District and may also be obtained from the DIR website.

This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the DIR under Labor Code Section 1771.4. No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal or awarded a contract unless registered with the DIR pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5.

The District reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any irregularity, and to take all bids under advisement for a period not to exceed 60 calendar days.
